This inner class holds getters and setters for each control object used by the controller. The problem is that these classes in general look like this: public class AbstractControllers { private String someControlObj; public abstract void setSomeControlObj(String someControlObj); public abstract String getSomeControlObj(); } The issue comes when trying to implement the same mechanism in more than one AbstractControllers, because then the overridden getters are not generic anymore.
